- teach a maximum of six course credits per term, and a maximum of nine credits per Academic year (July 1 – June 30), or summer and winter terms combined.

If one or more of the above requirements cannot be ticked, the Supervisor and Graduate Chair must provide for justification for requesting an exception to Policy #75.
